Småjondølene was started by Karin Brennesvik in 1971. The group today is comprised of approximately 45 people from the ages of 6-30 years old. Many of the members are the children or grandchildren of past members.

The dancers and musicians are in the top of their class in competition. They recently won the silver prize in world championship folkdancing in Mallorca.
